1 Testament Robert Tanner al[ia]s Greeneland th[e] elder de
2 Henley uppon Thames
3 In the name of god Amen: the Five and Twenteth day of
4 March in the yeare of our Lord God One Thousand Six
5 Hundred twenty and two I Robert Tanner Al[ia]s Greeneland
6 th[e] elder of Henley upon Thames in the Countie of Oxon
7 yeoman beinge sicke of body but of good & p[er]fecte memorye
8 all thanks therfore I render unto allmightie god callinge to
9 my remembrance that flesh is mortall & naturallie borne to
10 die and to depart out & from this transitorie life the time
11 and place ^{thereso} beinge uncertaine Have therof thought
12 good to ordaine & make this my last will and testament in
13 manner and forme followinge that is to saie, First I com[m]end
14 my soule into the hands of Almightye god my maker and of
15 Jesus Christ my redeemer and of the holie ghost my comforter
16 hopeinge to be saved by the only merritts of Christ his passion
17 Item I give and bequeath unto the poore people of Henley
18 afore saide twentie shillinges of lawfull mony of England
19 to be given & distributed amongst them, Item I give and
20 bequeath unto Robert Tanner al[ia]s Greeneland my Grandchild
21 the bedsted bedd & beddinge w[i]th all the furniture standinge
22 and beinge in the Chamber wherin I doe nowe lye in Henley
23 afore saide except all the painted clothes ^{hanginge} in the same Chamber
24 which painted clothes I give & bequeath unto Susan ~~my~~
25 Barfoote my dawghter Item I give & bequeath unto the said
26 Robert Greenland my Gr[a]ndchilde three silver spoones & the

27 best brasse pott w[hi]ch I have at Henley Item I give & bequeath
28 unto ^{the} said Susan Barfoote my dawghter three other silver
29 spoones and all ye rest of my brasse at Henley and my best
30 coverlet there Item I give & bequeath unto Walter Barfoote
31 my sonne in lawe & to his heires & assignes forever all that my
32 messuage or Ten[emen]t w[i]th the the backside garden and orchard
33 therunto adioyninge and belonginge w[i]th the apputenances
34 ~~the~~ nowe in the occupation of the saide Walter Barfoote
35 or his assignes scituate lyeinge & beinge on the North
36 side of the New streete in Henley upon Thames aforesaid
37 in the said Countie of Oxon betweene ye ten[emen]t and land
38 of Thomas Wintor on the East p[ar]t ^{and} the Ten[emen]t and
39 land of Raph Cutler on the West part and all such goodes
40 Implem[en]ts and household stuffe I lately heretofore demised &
41 graunted unto the said Walter Barfoote by lease as
42 Standarde. to remaine in or about the said Messuage or
43 Ten[emen]t And alsoe all the estate right tithes & interest whatsoever
44 w[hi]ch I the said Robert Tanner al[ia]s Greenland th[e] elder nowe
45 have or of right ought to have of in or to the same
46 messuage or Ten[emen]t: backside garden or orchard herein before
47 mentioned to be given ^{and} bequeathed Togeather w[i]th the deed
48 of conveyance to mee therof made to the Warden Bridgemen
49 Burgesses & Commalities of the Towne of Henley upon
50 Thames aforesaide. The said Walte[r] Barfoote & his executors
51 or administrators yealdinge & payinge for the same unto the
52 executor of mee the said Robert Greeneland th[e] elder hereafter
53 named the full some of One Hundred and Nine poundes
54 of lawfull mony of England at such daies & times as are
55 menc[i]oned and exp[r]essed in the draft of certaine articles
56 of agreement drawne in pap[er] made betweene me the said
57 Robert Greeneland th[e] elder & Robert Greeneland my
58 sonne of th[e] one part and the said Walter Barfoote
59 of th[e] other part. All the rest of my goods Cattells & Chattells debtes

60 ~~and~~ dueties and demaundes unbequeathed I doe hereby give &
61 bequeath unto Robert Tanner al[ia]s Greeneland my sonne whome
62 I doe make and ordaine to be the full & sole Executor of this
63 my last will & Testament and I doe ordaine and appoint my
64 loveinge frende Henry Emlie ~~and~~ of Henley aforesaid gent
65 and Frances Buck of the same Towne yeoman to be overseres
66 of this my last will & Testament and doe request them to see
67 the same dueite executed & p[er]formed accordinge to the true
68 meaninge ~~of this~~ hereof and doe give to either of them
69 for there paines to be taken therein six shillings & eight pence
70 a peece of lawfull mony of England In wittnes whereof the
71 saide Robert Tanner al[ia]s Greeneland th[e] elder have unto this my
72 last will & Testament sett my hand and seale the day and
73 yeare first above written Item I doe alsoe give & bequeath
74 unto Dorothe Francklin my Grandchild fortie shillings of
75 lawfull mony of England to be paid to her by my saide executor
76 before named The RG marke of Robert Tanner al[ia]s Greeneland
77 th[e] elder Sealed & delivered to be the saide Greeneland ye elder as
78 his last will & testament in the p[re]sence of Henry Emilie
79 John Heath Solomon Sewne [*Sewen*] and Henry Buck
