Transcriber's Notes – Transcribed by Sara-Jayne Boughton. Original spelling preserved. Important information from Latin noted. The brackets denote abbreviated letters or words. Line 51 – it may be that 'fatts' was meant to be 'vatts' as this would make more sense in the context, however the original word has been preserved. Again, Line 51, the word 'tens' was an educated guess as this is definitely what it appears to spell, however it was thought that this might have been where the material that the sieves are made of would be mentioned.
