Transcriber's Note – Transcribed by Sara-Jayne Boughton. The Latin and 'In Good and bad debts/ about' was added after the original inventory which can be told by a much heavier pen, and the former was parallel with the final inscription of the executors names, hence the restructuring of the format. Some difficulty in transcribing the last three lines of the preamble which is in Latin as much was abbreviated, but the missing letters from the abbreviations are filled in between square brackets. Similarly, the word 'no[t?]e' on line 11 was difficult to decipher but the 't' again is an estimated guess by myself and Paul. No lines were started with Impris., Imprimis, or 'it:' for item, or was a total given hence these were left out of the format. No overleaf present. Preamble moved to reflect position on page in relation to the rest of the text. Key information from the Latin is given, which was difficult to extract as much of the Latin was abbreviated.
