

Jone Hawtrell of Old Basing, widow 1589

1589 the sixth of December in the 32nd year of the reign of our Sovereigne Lady Elizabeth by the grace of God Queen of England, France etc.

In the name of God Amen I Jone Hawtrell of Basing in county of Southampton widow do make and ordain my last will and testament in manner and form following. **First** I commit my soul in to the hands of the living God my Creator having an assured hope of salvation by Christ's death and passion and my body to be buried in the church litten of Basing. **Item** I give to Elyzabeth Hall the daughter of William Hall my son in law £3 6s 8d. **Item** I give to Jone Hall another daughter of the same William Hall £3 6s 8d. **Item** I give to Ollyffe Hall another daughter of the same William Hall £3 6s 8d, also I will if it please God to call any of them to his mercy before they come to their lawful age, her or their parts to be equally divided amongst the rest or the longest liver of them at her or their lawful age. **Also** I will and bequeath to Allse Eger the wife of Olyver Eger my daughter ten pounds of lawful money of England which I will shall remain in William Hall's custody, my son in law, whom I do ordain my executor for six years after my decease. **Item** I give to John Alstone the son of John Alstone my brother late deceased 20s. **Item** I give to Julian Funge the wife of John Funge ten shillings and 2 bushels of wheat, a bushel of [lundig]. **Item** I give to William Funge six shillings. **Item** I give to Amy Funge 5s. **Item** I give to Alse Funge 5s and one little chest standing in my chamber. **Item** I give to William Wakefield the son of Barnard Wakefield a stall of bees standing at John Blake's. **Item** I give to Margaret Loder the daughter of Zacary Loder a stall of bees standing at Beaglys. **Item** I give to Georg Hawtrell the son of John Hawtrell my son a blue heckferth. **Item** I give to Elnar the wife of William Hall and Alse the wife of Olyver Eger my daughters all my stuff of household which was not given by the last will and testament of Georg Hawtrell late deceased, my husband, to be equally divided between them. **Item** I give to Rachell Sevins 20s, also I give to Zachary Loder 2s, also I give to Nycholas Woodes 2s, which two last named I do desire to be my overseers to this my will and testament. **All the** residue of my goods and cattle as well moveable as unmoveable I give unto William Hall my son in law whom I do make my only and whole executor and also to see my funeral and all other ordinary charges paid by the same William my executor. **Witness** of the truth of this will Jone Hawtrell – mark.
